The report of the Local Inquiry Committee was considered by the Academic Council and the Syndicate at their meetings held on 24th March, 1971, and 5th April, 1971, respectively.

The resolution of the Academic Council and the report of the Syndicate are as follows:-

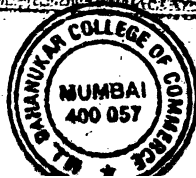
## Resolution of the Academic Council

It was resolved that it be reported to the Syndicate that, in the opinion of the Council, the affiliation of the M. L. Dahanukar College of Commerce, Bombay, to the University for the teaching of the courses of study leading to the B.Com. degree examination with the special subjects of (1) Accounting and Auditing, and (2) Banking and Finance, be made permanent with effect from 20th June, 1971, subject to the fulfilment of the following condition to the satisfaction of the Syndicate on or before 15th May, 1971. (The condition is the same as that mentioned in the above-mentioned resolution.)

## Report of the Syndicate

The Syndicate, after considering the report of the Local Inquiry Committee and the resolution of the Academic Council thereon, reports to the Senate that they are of the opinion that the affiliation of the M. L. Dahanukar College of Commerce, Bombay, to the University for the teaching of the courses of study leading to the B.Com. degree examination with the special subjects of (1) Accounting and Auditing and (2) Banking and Finance, be made permanent with effect from 20th June, 1971, subject to the fulfilment of the following condition to the satisfaction of the Syndicate on or before 15th May, 1971:-

At their meeting held on 30th April, 1971, the Senate considered the above application together with the report of the Local Inquiry Committee, the resolution of the Academic Council thereon and the report of the Syndicate in the matter.

Professor H. V. Chatalis move, as recommended by the Syndicate and Professor T.A. Khat seconded :-

"That the Senate approve of the report of the Syndicate in the matter of the permanent affiliation of the M. L. Dahanukar College of Commerce, Bombay, and record their opinion that the affiliation of the College to the University, for the teaching of the courses of study leading to the B.Com. degree examination with the special subjects of (1) Accounting, and Auditing and (2) Banking and Finance, be made permanent with effect from 20th June, 1971, subject to the fulfillment of the following condition to the satisfaction of the Syndicate on or before 15th May, 1971 :-

That the college authorities have given an undertaking in writing that they will incur a recurring expenditure of Rs. 15,000/- per year on the purchase of books and journals for the college library."

## II REPORT OF THE LOCAL INQUIRY COMMITTEE

Pursuant to your letter, No. AB/Recog/23278-75, dated 8th December, 1970, we formed ourselves into a committee to make a local inquiry in respect of an application, No. 1/702, dated 26th August, 1970, from the Principal of the M. L. Dahanukar College of Commerce for the permanent affiliation of the college for the teaching of the courses of study leading to the B.Com. degree examination, with the special subjects of (1) Accounting and Auditing, (2) Banking and Finance and (3) Business Management. We visited the college on Wednesday, 10th December, 1970, at 10-00 a.m. We were received by Principal M. D. Limaye, Shri M. Y. Paranjpe, Hon. Secretary of the Parle Tilak Vidyalaya and Shri S. G. Pethkar, Hon. Treasurer and were supplied with all the relevant information. We have to report as follows:—

**Governing Body:** The college is managed by the Parle Tilak Vidyalaya Society, which is a society registered under the Societies' Registration Act XXI of 1890, which has been recognized by the University as a regularly constituted body. The Board of Directors of the Parle Tilak Vidyalaya Society constitutes the Governing Body of the college. The Board of Directors have the power to appoint committees of management to conduct, control and supervise one or more institutions established by the Vidyalaya and such a committee (called the Standing Committee) of which the Principal is a member has been constituted for the M. L. Dahanukar College. The preparation of statement of accounts and budget of the college for the sanction and approval of the Board of Directors of the Vidyalaya is one of the functions of the committees. An advisory Committee has also been constituted for the college. We suggested to the Principal and the representatives of the Vidyalaya the desirability of appointing some more independent persons having expert knowledge of higher education in Commerce on the Committee and they agreed in principle to the enlargement of the committee by appointing at least one more outside educationist on the Committee.

**Staff:** The Staff position is satisfactory. Professor L. M. Dani, Professor of Commerce was designated as Head of the Department of Business Management from June, 1970 when the college started the teaching of Business Management as a special subject for the B.Com. degree examination. Ordinarily, the appointment of a full-time Professor of Business Management would be necessary. However, having regard to the qualifications of Professor Dani, the arrangement made by the college in appointing him as Head of the Department of Business Management was approved. As Professor Dani is now Head of the Department of Business Management, he should be designated as Professor of Business Management and a Professor of Commerce should be appointed.

The college has not been able to appoint a part-time Professor of Marketing and Sales-Management in accordance with the condition laid down in connection with the extension of affiliation of the college for the teaching of the subject of Business Management. The difficulty was that no suitable person of good standing in the subject was available. The college has made arrangements for the teaching of Marketing and Sales-Management by the appointment of a Visiting Lecturer. We have made recommendations elsewhere in this report with regard to the staff for the teaching of Business Management.

**Library:** The college is, at present, required to spend a sum of Rs. 10,000 per year on the purchase of books and journals for the college library in subjects other than Business Management and a further sum of Rs. 1,000 per year for the purchase of books and journals in the subject of Business Management. We recommend that the college should spend annually a sum of Rs. 1,000 for the purchase of books and journals in subjects other than Business Management and a further sum of Rs. 1,000 per year for the purchase of books and journals in Business Management. A provision of Rs. 15,000 has been made in the budget of the college for the year 1970-71 for the purchase of library books and journals.

**Reserve Fund:** The college authorities have kept a sum of Rs. 1 lakh in fixed deposit with the Maharashtra State Co-operative Bank as Reserve Fund of the college.

**Amenities for students:** Provision has been made in the college building for indoor games. The college also has a play-ground adjacent to it.

**Hostel:** One of the conditions laid down in connection with the continuation of affiliation of the college was that plans for a hostel building with accommodation for at least 50 students would be submitted to the University on or before 31st March, 1970, and hostel building would be made ready on or before 31st March, 1971. The Principal in his present application has requested that this condition be waived as the demand for hostel accommodation is insignificant as most of the students belong to western suburbs of Bombay. We understand that after due consideration, the University authorities decided last year to waive the requirement in respect of hostel in the case of some of the Arts & Science colleges while recommending their applications for permanent affiliation. We are of the opinion that the construction of a hostel may not be made a condition precedent for granting permanent affiliation.

**Principal's quarters:** In connection with the continuation of affiliation granted last time the college was required to provide the Principal with residential accommodation on the college premises. We are glad to state that quarters have been constructed near the college for the Principals of the V. J. Dharmadhikari and the Parle College. The area of the Principal's quarters is 700 sq. ft. and the condition is therefore satisfied.

Besides the day classes the college conducts morning classes for employed students as permitted by the University. One of the Professors has been appointed in-charge of the morning classes as required by the University. The salary for that behalf and is paid a monthly allowance of Rs. 1000. We met some of the teachers and discussed with them the span of the time tables in general. The time tables are so arranged that teachers who come in the morning do not have to stay for more than 6 hours in the college.

**Parle Vihar Vidyalaya Trust, Dahanukar Institute of Commerce** is the owner of the premises of the college. In accordance with the University condition, the trust has agreed to use the premises for educational, cultural or allied purposes continuously and provided such use does not prejudicially affect the educational functions of the colleges. The Syndicate have granted permission to the Principal of the Dahanukar College of Commerce to run the library of the Institute and the Director of Dahanukar Institute. The library of the college is a common library and provision of Rs. 10,000/- has been made for the library. The library is open to all students of the college during the library hours. The Principal has also been granted permission to use the library for the Institute. We are of the opinion that while the library should be purely educational and should not be used for any other purpose. Similarly, the library of the Dahanukar Institute should be purely educational and should not be used for any other purpose. ## Number of students :

The college at present has 1374 students in the First Year, the Intermediate, the Junior and Senior B.Com. classes in the day and morning sessions taken together :-

The Syndicate have decided that the maximum number of students in a commerce college conducting morning/evening classes for employed students from the academic year 1970-71 be as under namely, not more than 1400 students provided, the number of students in the morning/evening classes for employed students is limited to 700 and the number of students in the regular day classes is limited to 1,250. The college may be permitted to admit students up to the maximum number permitted under the above mentioned decision of the Syndicate.

We recommend that the college be granted permanent affiliation for the teaching of the courses of study leading to the B.Com. degree examination with the special subjects of Accounting and Auditing and Banking and Finance, subject to the fulfilment of the following condition to the satisfaction of the Syndicate on or before 15th May, 1971.

"That the college authorities have given an undertaking in writing that they will incur a recurring expenditure of Rs. 15,000/- per year on the purchase of books and journals for the college library."

Business Management was introduced as a special subject only recently and courses of study in the subject are being developed in the light of the experience of the colleges in teaching the subject. We feel, therefore, that permanent affiliation should not be granted to any college for the teaching of this subject for the present.

We discussed with the Principal and the Head of the Department of Business Management arrangements for the teaching of the subject in the light of the new rationalised syllabus for the subject. We are of the view that with a view to properly meeting the requirements of teaching the subject, the Department of Business Management should have (a) a full-time Professor of Business Management and (b) (i) a part-time Professor of Financial Management and (ii) a part-time Professor of Marketing and Sales Management. We are not in favour of appointment of Visiting Lecturers for teaching the subjects of Financial Management and Marketing and Sales Management.

It may be observed in this connection that on the recommendation of the committee appointed by the Academic Council which had on it experts in Business Management, it was decided by the Syndicate on the recommendation of the Academic Council *inter alia* that the teacher in General Principles of Business Management should be a full-time teacher and that there should be part-time teachers in the subjects of Financial Management and Cost Accounting and Marketing and Sales Management. As a matter of concession, however, the colleges were permitted to carry on with visiting lecturers in the subjects of Financial Management and Marketing and Sales Management.

Sufficient time has not been given to fully carry out the requirements and therefore regular part-time teachers must be appointed in these subjects. Outside teachers can supplement the teaching by regular staff.

The part-time Professors should in our opinion be available to the students for at least 6 periods per week (at least 6 lecture periods and 2 contact periods). The part-time teachers should in our opinion be placed at least in the grade of Rs. 200-400.

We realise that there may be difficulty in obtaining the services of practising managers as part-time teachers. However, with efforts and suitable adjustment of time-tables, it should be possible for the colleges to secure the services of practising experts employed in commercial and industrial firms. In order to enable the colleges to do so, we recommend to the Syndicate that normal rule that a person who holds a full-time appointment elsewhere should not be appointed as part-time teacher may be waived in the case of subject of Business Management in the interest of development of the teaching of this subject in Commerce Colleges.

The college at present has a full-time Professor as Head of the Department of Business Management. There is also a part-time Professor in Marketing and Sales Management. The college should appoint a part-time Professor for teaching Marketing and Sales Management as required by the condition of affiliation. The present affiliation of the college in the subject of Business Management will continue till 15th June, 1972 and since as stated above, we are not in favour of granting permanent affiliation for the teaching of the subject, it is not necessary to make any recommendation with regard to the continuation of affiliation of the college in this subject at this stage.
